

Application for Admission Bachelor of Social Work – Nunavut Cohort

Program Requirements:

The Bachelor of Social Work (BSW), Nunavut Cohort, offered through a partnership between Nunavut Arctic College, Social Service Worker Program (NAC-SSWP) and Memorial University, School of Social Work (MUN-SSW), is designed for students who completed the NAC Social Services Worker Diploma. Applicants are required to have at least a 65% overall average in the NAC Social Services Worker Diploma and in any bridging courses offered in preparation for the BSW Nunavut.

English is the main language of instruction in the BSW Nunavut. Students must have a level of ability in English that allows them to participate fully in all aspects of course work.

The BSW Nunavut has a program residency requirement that requires students to take courses at the NAC campus where the program is offered. The location of the third cohort (2024-2025) is **Cambridge Bay**. Please contact Margaret Sullivan at Margaret.Sullivan@arcticcollege.ca to apply for NAC student housing.







The BSW, Nunavut Cohort has a program residency requirement that requires students to take courses at the NAC campus where the program is offered. The location of the third cohort (2024-2025) will be announced before the application deadline.

The BSW, Nunavut Cohort depends on the cooperation of community agencies to provide field practical and instruction to its students. Many of these agencies have a range of requirements, such as Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sectors checks. 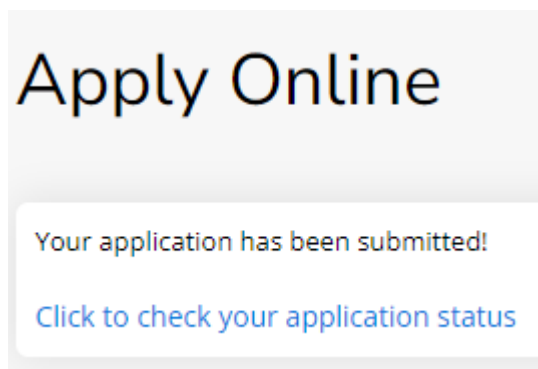
